DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I created No More Lights in the Sky to show a possible scenario that could be born out of the UK's current climate to make us think about our actions of today and the control that some can exert over others. I wanted to use the above to create a concept that has a Science Fiction theme but is kept simple and barren to reflect a hollow mood and environment, giving a stark contrasted mood to better reflect my feelings.

I wanted to also pose more questions than answers, and get the audience thinking and talking about how this could come about and how what we do today has a direct impact on the consequences of our futures. As such this film becomes a snapshot of the few to allow watchers to try and piece more of it together, and hopefully wish to learn more of the world presented.

To try and exercise my Directorship - plus also adopting the documentary feel much of this is presented in roaming one shots, to show a more realistic world within the film. I also allowed the main cast to change and work within a structured improvisation environment, as I felt this was key to show the "real" situations with greater impact in the film.

DANNY COTTON - WRITER/DIRECTOR

Danny is a Writer/Director from Norwich, England and has been making films since 2009, building up experience primarily as a Director but also in other roles including Camera Operator, First Assistant Director, Editor and others on many projects.

He studied two years of Film, Media and Photography at college gaining more experience through working in the visual medium, subsequently studying Film Production in a more formal setting during one year at university before going on to create his own short films building up his experience to get to this, his first feature length production.

Danny is currently working on the completion of his 2nd feature film called "Soldiers of Embers" and readying himself for more by writing other scripts in his favourite Science Fiction vein. He has received several Award wins, Nominations and Selections for his Writing, Direction and Producing.

MONTY JORDAN - ACTOR

Monty has spent the last decade working in theatre and independent film, mostly in Norwich and around East Anglia. He has performed in a diverse mix of productions, from Shakespeare plays to espionage films. More recently he has lent his voice to the lead character in an animated film, Tin Foil, which is also being produced by Fabrication Images and is due for release later this year. He also appeared this year in the hugely popular Norwich Medieval Mystery Plays, with productions in Norwich Cathedral and Castle.

Alongside his acting, Monty has spent recent years teaching English and drama, a lot of which has been abroad. He is due to move to South Korea to continue this avenue in the coming months but also has plans in place for future acting projects, both on stage and screen for his return.



MATT LONG - PRODUCER

Matt Long is a British Actor, Writer, Producer and company director of Multi Award winning British Independent Film company 'Bulldog Films Ltd'.

Although he started his entertainment career out on stage as a Catwalk model, he came to acting in his mid 30's training with the Theatre Royal Norwich.

Matt is a very versatile actor appearing in Theatre as well as in TV and Film in both the UK and U.S.A. His first self written feature film 'Soldiers of Embers' has built quite a following during its production with the trailer winning the 'Best Drama Trailer' category at the Hollywood Independent Media Festival. Matt also appeared on the front cover of the Daily Mail weekend magazine as Beethoven for over 100 million readers online and in print.
